Year 4 - Educational Visit to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard

Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Friday 19th June 2026**, Year 4 will be visiting The Mary Rose Museum in Portsmouth Historic Dockyard as part of our history topic about the Tudors. The visit will give your child the opportunity to experience what life was like in those times. During the visit, children will be taking part in a range of activities.

We shall leave school at 9.15am and return in time for normal collection at 3.25pm.

Children are required to wear their school sweatshirt or cardigan. However, they can wear casual trousers and comfortable footwear (trainers). We will be outside for some of the day, so please bring a waterproof coat, a hat, sun cream and a rucksack to carry their lunch and water bottle (the children will be carrying their bags with them). We will check the weather closer to the time.

Children will need to be provided with a packed lunch, a healthy snack and plenty to drink. Please do NOT provide fizzy drinks or any drinks in glass bottles. If you would like school to provide your child with a packed lunch, please make sure you complete the relevant section on our online form.

We may need some adult helpers for our trip. If you are interested, please complete the relevant section on our online form. We often receive more offers of help than we need, therefore, we will contact you if your application is successful. Once again, a huge 'thank you' to those parents who have already volunteered to help with this trip.
