Little City Role Play Visit

24th September 2026 & 24th June 2027

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our first topic in Year R, children will be learning about different places in Eastleigh and the various roles people have within the community. At the end of the half term, they will be encouraged to think about what they might like to be when they grow up.

To support this learning, Little City will be visiting school on **Thursday 24th September 2026** and again on **Thursday 24th June 2027**. They will transform the small hall into a range of exciting role-play areas, giving children the opportunity to explore different jobs and community roles through imaginative play. Children will spend time in each area, helping to develop their imagination, language, communication and social skills.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £9.50 per child towards the cost of these visits. If preferred, payment may be made in two instalments:

- **£4.75 by 31 July 2026**
- **£4.75 by 31 August 2026**

The most convenient way to make your contribution is online via Arbor. If you have not already registered to make payments in this way, please contact the school office. Please ensure payment is made by **4th September 2026** to ensure your child can participate in this wonderful experience.

We believe these visits will provide a valuable and enjoyable learning experience for the children. However, in accordance with the Governors' Educational Visits Policy, if we do not receive at least **85% of the total cost in voluntary contributions**, the visits will unfortunately have to be cancelled. If you are experiencing genuine financial difficulties, please contact the school in confidence so that we can discuss this with you individually.

During the visits, we will take photographs and videos which will be shared with you via Tapestry. When Little City returns in the summer term, you will have the opportunity to see how your child's confidence, language and role-play skills have developed throughout the year.

We look forward to sharing this memorable experience with the children.
